TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SPENCER TOWNSHIP:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of Spencer Township who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Township Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the Township Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with Spencer Township Clerk is **Monday, April 22, 2019**

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Spencer Township Clerk's office, here at the following times:

- Any - Tuesday or Thursday from 9 a.m. to 12 pm or from 2 pm to 5 p.m.
- Any - Wednesday from 9 am to 12 pm
- Saturday, May 4th from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Sunday, May 5th from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.
- Monday, May 6th from 10 am to 4 pm
- Election Day, Tuesday May 7th from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

LAKEVIEW COMMUNITY SCHOOLS SINKING FUND MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Lakeview Community Schools Sinking Fund Millage Proposal

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Lakeview Community Schools, Montcalm, Mecosta and Kent Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1.5 mills (\$1.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2019 to 2023, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the construction or repair of school buildings, for school security improvements, for the acquisition or upgrading of technology and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2019 is approximately \$500,000?
